As per the Circular read as 1st above Government have directed all the Government officers, staff and Employees in the State to use the symbol ₹ of Indian Rupee instead of any other sign presently in use.

Finance (IT-TD) Department has requested to issue necessary instructions to use ₹ in T.R forms also so that the same change can be effected in the forms published on the website.

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord sanction to use the symbol ₹ for Indian Rupees in T.R forms in K.T.C Volume II and also to substitute the symbol ₹ in K.T.C. Volume I & II wherever the symbol Indian Rupee appears.

Necessary amendments will be made in KTC Volume I & II separately.
